

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
EITZEN CITY COUNCIL  
December 8, 2020**

The regular meeting of the Eitzen City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Mayor Jeffrey Adamson. Council members present were Doug Meyer, Mitch Lutichens, Matt Sauer and Emily Burrichter. Also in attendance were City Clerk Steve Schuldt, M.D. Supervisor Darryl Meyer and guest Dan Esser.

Plans for a new garage at 125 East Main Street were presented by Dan Esser. Following discussion and there being no setback issues or concerns, Councilmember Lutichens moved, second by Councilmember Burrichter and the motion passed to approve the building permit.

Minutes of the November 10, 2020 regular meeting were read. Councilmember Sauer moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to approve the minutes.

November financial statements were reviewed. Councilmember Lutichens moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to approve the financial statements.

Mayor Adamson updated council regarding the investigation of an encounter with a 3 member team of CDC employees. No action was pursued by law enforcement.

Council reviewed and discussed the 2021 budget. Councilmember Lutichens moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to approve a 2021 tax levy of \$115,340.00

Council was informed that fabric is continuing to be flushed into the city sewer system along Townline Road. The lift station was again completely entangled and inoperable due to the material. A letter has been sent to residents along Townline Road, instructing them to not flush anything other than toilet paper. If the problem persists, residents will be contacted personally.

Council reviewed November claims payable. Councilmember Lutichens moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to pay all claims.

There being no further business, Councilmember Sauer moved, second by Councilmember Lutichens and the motion passed to adjourn at 7:47 pm.
