

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
EITZEN CITY COUNCIL
May 11, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Eitzen City Council was called to order at 7:05 pm by Mayor Jeffrey Adamson. Council members present were Mitch Lutichens, Emily Burrichter, Doug Meyer and Mitch Lange. Also in attendance were city clerk Steve Schuldt and Charlene Selbee from the Fillmore County News.

Minutes of the April 13, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Councilmember Meyer moved, second by Councilmember Burrichter and the motion passed to approve the minutes.

April financial statements were reviewed. Councilmember Lutichens moved, second by Councilmember Burrichter and the motion passed to approve the financial statements.

Under old business, Mayor Adamson reported that electric poles will be inspected in July or August. Estimates for a new sidewalk have not been received yet. Crack filling and Winnebago Ave. overlay have not been scheduled yet.

Mayor Adamson reported that ball park lights are on hand but not yet installed. Electrical outlets are ready and the Lions Club executive committee is meeting with Fun Fest vendors to view the set up.

Mayor Adamson reported a resident complaint of 2 barking dogs with one showing aggressive behaviour. A letter is to be sent to the owner.

Council was informed of a meeting with Kent Whitcomb and Brian Krambeer of MiEnergy Co-op on May 26, 2021 to discuss 2021 municipal electric rates.

Doug Meyer informed council of a June 7, 2021 meeting with the Fire Department, County Law Enforcement and the City to discuss Family Fun Fest activities and procedures.

Council was informed that new tires have been installed on the sewer pivot after 40 years of use. Repairs have been completed on the street at Townline Road and Carsten Corner Drive.

Council reviewed April claims payable. Councilmember Lutichens moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to pay all claims.

There being no further business, Councilmember Burrichter moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to adjourn at 7:25 pm.
