

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
EITZEN CITY COUNCIL  
June 8, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Eitzen City Council was called to order at 7:04 pm by Mayor Jeffrey Adamson. Council members present were Mitch Luttreich, Emily Burrichter, Doug Meyer and Mitch Lange. Also in attendance were city clerk Steve Schuldt, maintenance supervisor Darryl Meyer, Charlene Selbee from the Fillmore County News and Larry Nierling.

Minutes of the May 11, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Doug Meyer moved, second by Emily Burrichter and the motion passed to approve the minutes.

May financial statements were reviewed. Mitch Luttreich moved, second by Emily Burrichter and the motion passed to approve the financial statements.

Under old business, Mayor Adamson reported that electric poles will be inspected in July or August. Estimates for a new sidewalk have not been received yet.

Mayor Adamson reported that ball park lights are on hand but not yet installed. Electrician Pat Jilek is waiting for a lift to become available.

Mitch Luttreich moved, second by Doug Meyer and the motion passed to approve a temporary liquor license for the Eitzen Lions Club during the July 4<sup>th</sup> celebration

Doug Meyer reported that the Eitzen Fire Department met with Houston County law enforcement and Caledonia Ambulance Service to coordinate the July 4<sup>th</sup> event in Eitzen.

Council members reviewed and discussed a proposal to blacktop Carsten Corner just north of Townline Drive. Doug Meyer moved, second by Mitch Luttreich and the motion passed approve the bid submitted by Dunn Blacktop Company for the amount of \$15,960.00.

Mayor Adamson reported that notices have been delivered to residents along Townline Drive regarding issues with flushing products that are not meant to enter the sanitary sewer system.

Council was informed of an incident in which a child was bitten by an unrestrained dog. The dog's owner has been contacted personally and is to be given a written warning. Mayor Adamson asked that the council discuss the dog ordinance at next month's council meeting.

Council reviewed May claims payable. Doug Meyer moved, second by Mitch Luttreich and the motion passed to pay all claims.

There being no further business, Doug Meyer moved, second by Mitch Luttreich and the motion passed to adjourn at 7:47 pm.
