

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
EITZEN CITY COUNCIL
August 10, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Eitzen City Council was called to order at 6:05 pm by Mayor Jeffrey Adamson. Council members present were Mitch Luttchens, Emily Burrichter, Doug Meyer and Mitch Lange. Also in attendance were city clerk Steve Schuldt and maintenance supervisor Darryl Meyer.

Minutes of the July 13, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Emily Burrichter moved, second by Doug Meyer and the motion passed to approve the minutes.

July financial statements were reviewed. Doug Meyer moved, second by Mitch Luttchens and the motion passed to approve the financial statements.

Under old business, Mayor Adamson reported that electric poles will be inspected in August. Estimates for a new sidewalk have not been received yet. Dog ordinance discussion is to take place at a future meeting. A barking dog complaint at 509 Main Street E. has been resolved.

Mayor Adamson informed council that a Lion's member questioned billing by Brad's Electric for electrical outlets outside the community center. The outlets were installed for use by food vendors during the Family Fun Fest and had been requested by the Lions Club. The Lions Club is to be referred to Brad's Electric for questions regarding the outlet installation.

Mayor Adamson inquired if council would prefer an earlier starting time for future meetings. Council by consensus agreed to start meetings at 6:00 pm.

Mayor Adamson informed council of the receipt of \$13,174.22 in American Rescue Plan funding. Use of the funds will be determined at a future meeting.

Mayor Adamson read a thank you card from the family of Garnett Deters for remembrance and flowers at the funeral.

Council was informed that the ball field lights are inadequate as installed and could pose a danger for outfield players. Brad's Electric is to be contacted to remedy the matter.

Mitch Luttchens informed council that ESB Banking is offering to contribute toward a splash pad or provide bussing to and from swimming pools at Caledonia or Spring Grove. Council will seek additional information regarding installation of a splash pad.

Council was reminded of an upcoming fund raising benefit at the Community Center for Russ Breeser on August 14.

Council reviewed July claims payable. Mitch Luttchens moved, second by Mitch Lange and the motion passed to pay all claims.

There being no further business, Emily Burrichter moved, second by Mitch Luttchens and the motion passed to adjourn at 6:40 pm.
