

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
EITZEN CITY COUNCIL  
December 14, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Eitzen City Council was called to order at 6:03 pm by Mayor Jeffrey Adamson. Council members present were Mitch Luttcens, Doug Meyer and Mitch Lange. Emily Burrichter was absent. Also in attendance was city clerk Steve Schuldt and guest Charlene Selbee from Fillmore County Journal.

Minutes of the November 10, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Doug Meyer moved, second by Mitch Lange and the motion passed to approve the minutes.

November financial statements were reviewed. Mitch Luttcens moved, second by Mitch Lange and the motion passed to approve the financial statements.

Sidewalk construction is tabled. Dog ordinance discussion is to take place at a future meeting. Council discussed use of American Rescue Plan funds totalling \$13,174.22. Council is considering standby generators for the fire station, well house and community center. A representative from Kish and Sons Electric will present a proposal at a future meeting. Council discussed the need for roof replacement at the community center. No action was taken.

Council discussed the Winnebago Avenue lift station repair costs to be submitted for reimbursement. Council decided that \$45.00 per hour was a reasonable labor charge for those that worked on the project. Billing for labor will be \$1,575.00 ( 4 workers @ \$45.00/Hr. For 35 hours ).

Council discussed the 2022 tax levy. Mitch Luttcens moved, second by Doug Meyer and motion passed certify the final levy amount of \$118,000.00.

Council members were informed that the Lions Club "Breakfast with Santa" held December 11<sup>th</sup> was well attended.

Council reviewed November claims payable. Mitch Lange moved, second by Doug Meyer and the motion passed to pay claims.

There being no further business, Mitch Luttcens moved, second by Mitch Lange and the motion passed to adjourn at 6:30 pm.
