

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
EITZEN CITY COUNCIL
June 9, 2020**

The regular meeting of the Eitzen City Council was called to order at 7:01 pm by Mayor Jeffrey Adamson. Council members present were Emily Burrichter, Doug Meyer, Matt Sauer and Mitch Luttcens. Also in attendance were City Clerk Steve Schuldt and Maintenance Supervisor Darryl Meyer. Guest attending the meeting was Larry Nierling.

Minutes of the May 12, 2020 regular meeting were read. Councilmember Meyer moved, second by Councilmember Burrichter and the motion passed to approve the minutes.

May financial statements were reviewed. Councilmember Sauer moved, second by Councilmember Luttcens and the motion passed to approve the financial statements.

Council discussed the park dedication and city picnic. The event will remain pending until the stay-at-home order is lifted.

Council discussed the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Council was informed that there are now 5 cases in Houston County.

Council was informed that They will pull the well again to investigate issues when the pump starts.

Mayor Adamson informed council that Caledonia Schools football and baseball should begin practice on June 15.

Council by consensus decided to reopen the community center with users to follow state guidelines in light of COVID-19.

Council discussed the condition of power poles in the city and suggest the city look into having them inspected.

Mayor Adamson informed council that the Lions plan to sell raffle tickets and have fireworks on July 4th. There was also talk of a limited parade. The community center is to be left available for use by the Lions Club during the July 4th weekend.

Council discussed purchasing a sanitizer/fogger to be used in public areas after large gatherings. No action was taken.

Mayor Adamson and councilmember Sauer and Luttcens were reminded that their terms will expire in 2021 and they will need to file for re-election in August.

Council discussed selling the used pipe from Well #3. Council decided by consensus to offer the pipe for sale at \$50.00 per section.

Council reviewed May 2020 claims payable. Councilmember Luttcens moved, second by Councilmember Sauer and the motion passed to pay all claims.

There being no further business, Councilmember Meyer moved, second by Councilmember Luttcens and the motion passed to adjourn at 7:30 pm.
