

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
EITZEN CITY COUNCIL  
October 13, 2020**

The regular meeting of the Eitzen City Council was called to order at 7:03 pm by Mayor Jeffrey Adamson. Council members present were Emily Burrichter, Doug Meyer, and Mitch Lutichens. Matt Sauer was absent. Also in attendance were City Clerk Steve Schuldt and guest Larry Nierling.

Minutes of the September 8, 2020 regular meeting were read. Councilmember Burrichter moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to approve the minutes.

September financial statements were reviewed. Councilmember Burrichter moved, second by Councilmember Lutichens and the motion passed to approve the financial statements.

Council discussed the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. No action was taken.

Council reviewed the CARES Act budget. \$10,449.00 has been spent with \$7,783.00 remaining.

Mayor Adamson updated council regarding an encounter with a 3 member team of CDC employees conducting COVID-19 testing in the community without prior notification. The incident is currently under investigation by law enforcement. Representative Greg Davids and Senator Jeremy Miller are urging Governor Walz and the head of the Minnesota CDC to retract their defamatory statements toward the City of Eitzen and its citizens.

Council agreed by consensus that Halloween trick or treating in the city can take place as usual, however, there will not be a Halloween party at the Community Center this year.

Council was informed that 6 security cameras have been installed in and around city hall and fire station.

Council was informed that a new cooler has been installed at the Community Center.

Council was informed that long time resident Dolores Brumm has passed away.

Council reviewed September claims payable. Councilmember Meyer moved, second by Councilmember Burrichter and the motion passed to pay all claims.

There being no further business, Councilmember Burrichter moved, second by Councilmember Meyer and the motion passed to adjourn at 7:46 pm.
