

WHAT IS RECYCLABLE?

PLASTICS:

- Soda Bottles
- Milk Jugs
- Shampoo Bottles
- Contact Solution Bottles
- Detergent Bottles
- Motor Oil Bottles (Must be drained)

Includes all plastic containers with these numbers on them.



TIN AND ALUMINUM

- Aluminum and Tin Cans
- Aluminum Foil and Pie Plates (Cannot be soiled with food)
- Wire Clothes Hangers
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Metal Pots and Pans

CARDBOARD/PAPER:

- Any type of corrugated boxes
- Cereal Boxes (Inserts removed)
- Soda Boxes & Beer Cartons
- Mail and Envelopes (Plastic windows are OK)
- Shredded Paper (Must be placed in plastic bag)
- Magazines and Catalogs
- Phone Books
- Pizza Box Covers (Greasy bottoms should be placed with the trash)
- Egg cartons

GLASS JARS AND BOTTLES:

- Any clear or colored jars and bottles

WHAT IS NOT RECYCLABLE IN THIS SYSTEM?

- No garbage
- No food waste
- No food-tainted items (used paper plates or boxes, paper towels or paper napkins)
- No ceramics & dishware
- No windows & mirrors
- No plastic wrap
- No packing peanuts or bubble wrap
- No wax boxes
- No photographs
- No medical waste
- No polystyrene or Styrofoam
- No hazardous chemical containers
- No foam egg cartons
- No wood
- No light bulbs
- No yard waste or garden tools
